TAC (per Paul Moore)

The summer rally season is off and running with TAC hosting three events so far.

On April 23rd the Ralliette series was kicked off with an event through the hills in the Bellefontaine area. Four teams battled for the first points of the 2008 season. May 21st saw the second Ralliette event run with seven teams covering ground north and west of Mississauga. In both cases, the routes, instructions, overall events were run without issues.

On May 31st, TAC hosted its second of three ORRC events, the Discover Ontario Rally. The route took the nine teams north and east from Brechin, Ontario through the Kawartha Lakes region. The route was excellent, covering ground that had not seen a ORRC rally in many years. The event attracted 7 novice entrants. TAC would like to thank the owner and staff of the Wild Wings in Brechin for their hospitality at the start and end of the rally.

Next up will be the June (25th) and July (23rd) Ralliettes at the Tim Horton's on Mississauga Road between the 401 and 407. Planning is also underway for the round six of the ORRC and the second running of the Infinite Monkeys Rally. The event will start and finish at the Super Burger at Highways 10 and 89 in Primrose, Ontario. The event will take teams over the "Roof of Ontario" on August 16th.

MCO (per Jim Morrow)

We had the first event in our Summer Night Rally (SNR) series while I was away in France, and it ran well although we only got eight teams out. Glen Clark of Open Road Motorsports is runing the series with prizes from Targa Newfoundland (Half price entry, Free Accommodation Package, Half price at a Targa School). The buzz is spreading around other marque clubs in the area and I expect much better numbers for our July event. We're also trying to use the event to get some older/vintage cars out.
