5. Old Business -

a. Tall Pines Vehicle Tracking – Ross/Pete G - Tall Pines committee agreed to use the EZTrak system for the event. It was mentioned in the Tall Pines Supp Regs that the system will be used. Bruce to check whether we need to post a notification that it is mandatory for all competitors.

b. LHFR Stewards Report – Warren – David Maynard has distributed his report to the Board. We are still waiting on Alasdair's report.

- c. Pre-Training of Seed 6 Drivers Warren An email was sent out to experienced drivers/co-drivers to see who would be interested in being involved in a mentoring program. So far we have had 2 responses. As there aren't many new competitors currently coming into the sport we don't need a huge response. We will keep developing the idea for the future.
- **d. 2015 AGM Location** Will return to the Peterborough location for March 19th 2016. We can discuss with the attendees the idea of moving the AGM to a different location in the future. Perhaps central to a different RSO club each year.
- e. OPRC Competitor Survey Bruce A google drive document has been developed with basic survey questions so far for competitors, to get a handle on the low entries/involvement in the sport. The Board and other members on the call have access to the file and can edit the questions/list of competitors to contact. Once we have an idea of competitor responses we can then have an open forum. This should include event organizers as well.

The survey should also be sent to Rally Sprint competitors. If we can get the survey completed and sent before Tall Pines that would be ideal, but not essential.

f. 2016 CDNrally plans – Warren - Current cost per event is roughly \$500. We need to promote it more and integrate it into events better than we do currently. CDNrally isn't looking to make a profit, but we all agree it is a useful tool, and one we need to make better use of.

Although Peter MacDonald may take more of a backseat in 2016 with regards to CDNrally, he will still be very much involved. Jeremy Norris has been discussing with CDNrally the idea of bringing in a couple more camera guys, and looking for sponsorship dedicated solely to production of the OPRC coverage.

The Board agreed to let Jeremy take charge of rounding up the sponsorship money needed to meet the cost challenge.

11. Growth Initiatives -

Jeremy Norris has requested to be involved with Growth Initiatives. Over the past 3 years, competitor participation has decreased by 42%. By evaluating the reasons why participation has declined, Jeremy hopes to increase exposure of the sport, and make it easier to become involved in it. He's currently putting together a report in which he believes he has outlined the main reasons for this decline, with a plan addressing each area. He will send out the report to the BOD in the next few weeks, for feedback.

They will then use this to water the MLRC rallycross track, to cut down costs for events. MLRC is planning on making it available to rent to other clubs. By decreasing dust on the track, MLRC may be able to increase the number of events in a season. Currently the dust is a huge factor as to why summer rally crosses are not held.
