 - TP Regional Podium Warren will discuss regional podiums with TP coordinator in the next week to ensure the correct podiums are displayed.

- ii. **Results** Some minor corrections were made and are now up online.
- iii. **2016 OPRC Rule Set** 2 ideas were put forward for possible rule changes for the 2016 OPRC Rule Set (some discussion was had at the OPRC Growth Committee meeting the previous week)
 - Decrease the number of standalone events that a competitor must enter to 1 in order to be eligible for the OPRC- There was a lot of discussion with regards to this. Original rules were put in place when there were 4 standalone OPRC events – now there are only 3.
 - Peter Watt/Maynard proposed a *Motion to change the* number of standalone *OPRC* events competitors are required to enter in order to qualify for the *OPRC* to 1 event. 5 For. 1 Against. Carried
 - Allow competitors to be eligible for the Ontario Performance Rally Championship without holding a RSO affiliated Club membership – Not approved
 - It was decided that we still need to ensure that anyone who wished to be eligible for the OPRC needs to be a Club member. We do however need to make competitors aware that this is required. When promoting the OPRC we need to ensure competitors know they need to purchase a membership and perhaps have a 1 event grace period for them to decide if they want to participate in the championship.
 - Post the notice wherever OPRC promotion is being posted.
 - Ensure all competitors entering an event that are not RSO
 Affiliated Club members are aware that in order to be eligible to gain points in the OPRC they need a club membership
 - Encourage all OPRC events to include this notice in their Supplementary Regulations
 - Encourage all OPRC events to offer club membership on their event entry forms
 - Encourage all event registrars to remind any entrants they see are not Club members of the OPRC eligibility rules

11. Growth Initiatives – Jeremy

- So far the growth committee has had a good couple of meetings. Putting together a marketing plan, OPRC info guide, and requirements document for the OPRC website.
- There is a google drive available for shared media/photos/videos etc where organizers,
 Board members and committee members can post owned items that can be shared for promotional use.
- www.oprc.ca web domain has been renewed.
- <u>info@oprc.ca</u> is the email address that can be used by anyone needing any information on the OPRC.
- Currently looking to streamline the OPRC social media (Twitter, Instagram, YouTube, Facebook) by using content manager software.
- Also looking at pricing of promotional items: flags, tent etc.
- At the 2016 Budget meeting \$2000 was allocated for use by the Growth Committee to promote the sport
- Would like to book a 15-20 minute spot at the AGM/Awards lunch to show what we have planned for promoting/improving the OPRC.
- Changed a couple of words in the Sponsorship Contract Will recirculate to Board members with changes.

13. Club News -

- a. British Empire Motor Club (BEMC) (per Bob McCallum)
- b. Kitchener–Waterloo Rally Club (KWRC) (per Martin Loveridge)
 KWRC held elections at the Jan. 14th 2016 meeting and all the incumbents were returned.

Martin attended the CARS AGM on Saturday and the actual AGM portion went quickly. Most of the day was taken up with the board looking for feedback on how to address

the decline in entry levels for the national rallies. Focus groups were assigned and ideas reported but what became apparent to me is a good club system is the base for all the other activities. If clubs could become more cohesive, mentoring newcomers, having more social interaction and cross organizing events the entries in events will take care of themselves. The clubs are the only members of CARS and I think there could be more emphasis on club development.

In other news the the CARS new website will debut about the middle of February with a total of \$50k having been spent on it, the largest expenditure CARS has ever made excluding the filming and TV costs. Yokohama are not sponsoring any motorsports now, they spent their entire budget (\$60 Million a year for 5 years) on the Chelsea FA (Soccer to us). Searches for other sponsors continue without any positive results and we are lucky to have Subaru support us so well for so long.

Our annual awards dinner is on January 23rd in Ingersoll. It's much the same as previous years, we do roast beef, ham, potatoes and veg. Some people bring a salad or desert but it's not necessary. Plan on arriving about 6:00PM and we'll serve the food about 6:30. After dinner we'll re-arrange the chairs and do some awards to deserving club members then move on to our special guest speaker. You need to let me know how many are coming so we have enough food, just reply to this email or use the link.

This year we are very privileged to have Tom Burgess and his wife Ann as our guests, they are flying in from Parksville B.C. Tom began his rally career in 1959 using an MG-TD which proved somewhat unreliable so he moved on to an MG-A, winning the Thunderbird rally in 1963. He also won Thunderbird again in 2015. Tom has won events and championships as both a driver and co-driver throughout his career. If you look at the rule book under lifetime standings you'll see he still leads the Grand-Master category, and his name shows up as a championship winner throughout the years.

Tom also wrote the original performance rally rule book, was president of the predecessor to CARS and has stewarded Canadian, American and FIA rallies. I could go on and on, but it's best to come to the dinner and hear from him yourself. Tom is probably the most experienced person in rally in Canada or the US, don't miss it.

Dennis and Roger are organizing Frostbite on Jan. 30th. and we'll need competitors and checkpoints. If you're available, let us know. Instructions are almost ready to print.

Finally, Andrew, Teresa and Greg have been looking for new rallycross venues and may have found a useable place. It's early days but we should have a better idea of the feasibility in the next couple of weeks and we'll make an announcement as soon as we firm things up.
