4. CARS update - Darryl Malone

- Direction for vehicle tracking CARS currently awaiting the results of the recent petition with regards to tracking devices
 RSO stance Let each region & event chose what tracking system they want to use & not mandate a particular system
- b. CARS looking at changing O4WD (lower costs, lower speeds of top cars) Darryl is hoping to encourage them to only look at rule changes that will affect the top tier of cars, so as not to make it more expensive by introducing changes that all other team also have to spend the money to make changes.
- c. CARS signed sponsors (Subaru, Motul, Formula Photographic) not a lot of information on this yet.
- d. CARS regional scrutineer network Looking for a regional representative to work with scrutineers in other provinces to discuss general trends in issues or improvements that need to be made across the board Needs to be someone with experience in scrutineering Warren will stand as this position for now would be good to get more scrutineers trained up and involved. KWRC has a number of members that may be interested in getting into scrutineering. Bruce also suggested Jason Crandall as a trainee scrutineer.
- e. CARS tech committee has been form (Bruce, Ray, Boris, Chris, Darryl)
- f. Helmet rules to be updated **Been a push to change the rules to only** allow FIA spec helmets still under discussion
- g. Concussion test in research Researching a concussion test that can be applied to competitors involved in accidents during the event to establish appropriate medical attention – research still on going
- h. RSO member rally cross rule change proposals going to Admin Rules committee Clarification requested by some club members with regards to rallycross rules (specifically location of obstacles at the

side of the course) – Discussion was held earlier this evening – Minutes currently being typed up

- d. Motorama Event went very well Event roundup email sent to BOD after Motorama
- e. Rally Sprint Rule Change Recommendations sent to CARS some feedback from John Hall Majority of suggestions made can be regional level regulations (licencing, course cars/medics etc) Not enough data for average speed adjustments.
 2 main areas that were to be discussed at the CARS Rules Admin Committee meeting earlier tonight was
 - i. Length of event Maximum 40km & not to allow events to hold 2 events on the same day – supposed to be stepping stone – 40km is good distance for beginners
 - ii. Restrictors in Forced-induction vehicles RSO would like vehicles to follow CARS rules

Discussion was had tonight (Tues Apr 18 – CARS Rules Admin Committee) & results of that discussion will be forwarded to Kelly for RSO.

f. AGM - Guest speaker came to discuss distracted driving laws with regards to HAM radio operators – RSO & Clubs encouraged to write to individuals with details of why HAM operators are important to their events etc. – Bruce will be contacting clubs & individual events with regards to these letters; as well as Alasdair.

11. Growth Initiatives -

- **a.** Rally Perce Neige Video Released Monday April 17th posted on social media, OPRC & RSO websites
- b. CDN Rally Media Program 2017 Warren Covering costs for the program (request from Growth Committee) Media program for 2017 requires \$6600 to cover costs. The Growth Committee asked that discussion was had into committing to CDNRally for the 2017 coverage.

Mixed views on the coverage itself & how valuable it is. We don't need the money up front but CDNrally is looking for a commitment to the full season (5 remaining events) & we can pay per event.

Each Board member was asked to give their opinion of the program & their thoughts on where we should go from here. The growth committee is committed to drumming up

the sponsorship required for the program but there are concerns that enough money won't be raised & RSO will have to pay the balance.

Motion: RSO will provide CDNRally with direction to go ahead with the program with the understanding that the growth committee will offset the \$6600 cost through sponsorship Haywood/Maynard. 3 voted for/3 voted against. Tie vote. Remain status quo. Motion is defeated.

Discussion:

Deemed too much of a risk to commit to it at this point in time

Ross suggested maybe Clubs would like to opportunity to raise the money themselves.

Martin noted from an organizer point of view – they don't have any extra money to put towards the program without increasing fees on competitors.

RSO will not commit to the CDNRally program for 2017

Would like to create an RSO Organizer forum to meet a couple of times a year to discuss events, issues, ideas to improve them etc.
