- 2. Approval of the minutes of the last meeting (December 12 & Previous Nov 14) No additions or changes. Moved as presented. Mathew/Gulliver. Unanimous. Carried

3. Treasurer's Report – Pete Distributed to BOD. Some discussion on the financials. Moved for acceptance of the Treasurer's report as presented. Gulliver/Mathew

All invoices for the 2017 levies have gone out. Couple of timing invoices still coming in for 2016. Almost exactly breakeven – within \$100 or so.

4. CARS update - Peter Watt

Report to the RSO Board - CARS Dec. 14 and Jan. AGM Meeting and Activities There have been two CARS meetings since my last report

Meeting of Dec. 14, 2016:

- a. Preliminary finances for fourth quarter were presented income up \$63K over budget but expenses up \$77K over budget. 3 Year plan for funds transfer showing reduction in event, sanction, and licence rebates was presented. The RSO Region Rally director objected to the 2019 elimination of the licence rebate as that had a direct impact on the RSO budgeting. Other highlights included a small increase in the office manager's salary, a \$20 increase in licencing fees but no increase in insurance and no immediate increase in sanctioning fees.
 - Costs were added to provide for Technical Inspection Oversight at National events
- b. CRC as reported by National Series Manager.
 - i. Tall Pines ran well but had high attrition due to rough road conditions. The clerk informed the board that this was due to a deliberate act of sabotage by breaching a beaver dam. The perpetrator is known to the organizer.
 - ii. Big White has excellent conditions and roads but the incorporation of Rally Safe virtual chicanes led to protests. Results and podium delayed until the Rally Safe data could be obtained and verified.
 - iii. Perce Neige supp regs were published.
 - iv. All Canadian dates are now published and will include recce days.
- c. AGM will be held in Halifax. Meetings at the Westin Nova Scotian, Awards at the local Subaru dealership.
- d. Sponsorship negotiations with Subaru and Dirtfish, as well as the media contract with Bowes are ongoing
- e. Rule books are at the printers and will be delivered at the AGM
- f. Stewards' Manual to be completed on Dec. 19th
- g. Rule change clarifying Restart positioning and gaps presented and supported so Rules committee will adjust the wording.
- h. Growing entries will be a topic of discussing at AGM weekend meetings
- i. Suggestion of a competitor log book was rejected as methodology for tracking competitors' behaviour and competition record already exists through the office.

Meeting of January 6 & 7, 2017

Friday Evening:

- j. John Hall was elected CARS President for 2017. Mr. Hall made it abundantly clear that if the presidential duties interfered with his competition activities, he would resign his presidency. Additional board positions proposed to be finalized Sunday AM. (list available)
- k. The outgoing CARS treasurer reviewed the financials and presented the 2017 budget to be presented to the membership for the AGM. (CARS financial year runs from Dec. 1 to November 30.)
- I. The 3 year plan to revamp the CARS/Region/Event financial relationship received considerable negative support from the organizers. (pardon the oxymoron)
- m. Plans for future AGM's discussed: 2017 Montreal, 2018 Calgary, then alternating between Ottawa and Calgary

Saturday Meetings:

- n. 2017 National Stewards appointed by Terry Epp (List available)
- o. Discussion of presentation plan for AGM Meeting and contingency plan if budget rejected.
- p. Next CARS meeting set for Wednesday Jan. 18, 2017 at 19:00 EST
- q. Subaru representatives joined for an hour to discuss their directions for 2017 and beyond. Cost reduction and tightening of competition are on their priority list.
- r. Discussion of introducing a "STOP" sign along with the "OK" and "Red Cross" was discussed at the roundtable.

<u>The 2017 OPRC championship will not require RSO-affiliated Club membership for competitors to be eligible.</u>
