d. Rallycross Championship

A group in Ottawa area is hoping to put together some rallycross events – this will make 4 clubs running RX events. Discussion as to whether we should form a championship, but thought we should first nominate an advisor to research thoughts of the Clubs & see if there is any interest there – come up with a championship idea, prizes, funding ideas, etc. Bruce to discuss with Pete Gulliver to see if he would like to be involved with researching this idea

- Sweep 150 Event Tall Pines is their 30 year anniversary & 150 events. Ideas to present something to the Sweep Team video of thanks? Signed photo frame with sweep pic. There will be 6 teams at Pines (12 people).
- f. Tracker Purchase Discussion has been on going as to whether RSO would like to purchase trackers so we don't run into the logistical issues when trying to get them to OPRC (& rallysprint etc) events. Ross had some discussion with Peter MacDonald as he will be the EZTrak representative in Canada. MLRC would be interested in putting money towards purchasing a set but would like to know breakdown of costs with regards to purchase, running, updating etc. KWRC have been looking into building their own but there are a lot of costs associated with it.

Unit costs from Mark are approx. \$200USD – figure on needing 40 units = \$8000 – then monthly costs of SIM cards & data fees etc.

All agreed that its good for the sport to have them.
