 - **c. Timing Levies** Just waiting on payment from Tall Pines with regards to levies & road damage etc. =\$5500
 - **d. ORRC Stewards \$70?** This was entered in the wrong line & should be green crew. David to amend.

4. CARS update – Darryl Malone – November 7th CARS Meeting

- a. AGM Elections Western, Atlantic & Ontario Regional Rally Directors up for re-election.
- **b. Budget** isn't quite finished yet. Looking at increasing competitor licencing fees. Insurance fees will also increase next year due to deficit this year.
- **c. Sponsorship** Subaru will be providing same sponsorship it did for 2018 in 2019. Still working on Motul.
- **d. Pop-off Valve** Speed factor of 70+. Actual equipment is not available at the moment so CARS are considering delaying it for 6 months so that competitors are able to purchase and test.
- **e.** Charlevoix Scrutineering Some competitors were issued temporary log books at the event & then went on to compete at others & shouldn't have been able to CARS is looking into a way to electronically track that
- f. Charlevoix 2019 CARS still considering it for CRC 2019 good fit but some regions have expressed concerns that it will increase competitor costs as licence fees will increase. The budget will have to be adjusted to add Charlevoix in TBD as to how this will work out.

 - **a.** Trailer repairs are done & RSO decal for the back door will be stuck on once warm enough
 - **b.** Timing Team Tall Pines a lot of the regular team was assigned to other duties but it was still well covered
- **11. Growth Initiatives -** a few new members on the Growth committee calls Bruce to send Kelly login info to initiate calls. Some topics for discussion are sponsorship and motorama.

12. New Business -

- a. MCO Rallycross Darryl met with the organizers of this event along with Jim, Jeannie and the OSCC president. Very interested in being part of a rallycross championship. Invitational event this coming weekend to test the track. The following weekend is their first event. Safety plan has been submitted and in talks for insurance and permits. Very big facility (~100acres). 2 proposed tracks: Field/Parking lot = 1m30s with a possible extension into the forest loop. The second course is about 1m20s. MCO will run & fund it but being assisted by OSCC. MCO have the land leased for a year.
- **b.** Live video crash from Tall Pines CARS are not happy that the crash was broadcast as it had requested that there be a delay and the feed cut if there was an issue. CARS to look into developing a policy with regards to livestreaming at an event. Policy would be drafted and set to the admin rules committee to discuss.
- c. Rallysprint Series- Paul Hartl & Darryl have started a facebook discussion group with regards to a 2019 Rallysprint series. Lots of chatter. Aim is to have 3 events in 2019. Must fit with the current RSO calendar. Standalone events on gravel. In the process of drafting rules/regs for the series. Would like to collect money up front so organizers have a committed number to plan for. They would like RSO to collect the entry fees and

pay the events as the year goes along & would like to see it as an official RSO series. Discussion was also had with regards to awards but needs to be discussed further. Paul's role was to generate discussion & help start it up, Darryl was to work on admin, structure & see it through for the rest of the year.

So far, 2 clubs willing to host events (PMSC & MLRC). Dates need to be confirmed once RSO calendar up to date.

Was discussed to abide by the current CARS Rallysprint rules & see if anything needs adjusting in the future (& approaching CARS about it).

MOTION: RSO agrees to host a 3 event rallysprint series as well as agreeing to collect series entry fee and dispersing funds accordingly to organizers . Haywood/Mathew. Unanimous. Carried.

AGM is one of the largest expenses for CARS so good to do some shopping around to see where we can get a good deal. Need to start on this once we have requirements from Debbie.
