SECRETARY REPORT – 2019

2019 saw a few changes within Rallysport Ontario, & being involved with the Board allows me to stay in touch with the goings on in Ontario & Canadian rallying, even if I'm not competing much myself these days.

At the 2018 AGM in March 2019, we bid farewell to Bruce Leonard in the role of RSO President. Bruce had been in that position since I started with the BOD & did a great job in the role, but was getting involved in other projects so decided it was time to move on. Warren Haywood (former RSO VP Performance) was voted into the President position, bringing many years of experience in the sport, as well as many years involved with both the RSO and CARS Boards. Canadian Champion Co-driver Alan Ockwell was voted in as VP Performance, and David Maynard was voted back in as RSO Treasurer.

In 2019 there were 7 RallySport Ontario conference call meetings, attended by the RSO Board of Directors as well as a number of Club Representatives. I'd like to thank everyone for participating in those meetings, as it's very important that the clubs have an input into Rally in Ontario.
