- a. GlobalMeet (previous teleconferencing system) Turns out we did have a contract until Sep 2021. We had to pay \$180 to get out of the contract, but this has now been paid.
- **b. Sponsorship money** Will be moved to 2021 financials as it will be bumped to next season's OPRC.

4. CARS update - Warren -

Meeting Oct 19th 2020

a. Licensing:

- i. The BOD reviewed the status of licensing and proposed a credit structure for competitors who purchased licenses for the 2020 season and got partial value or no value from the fee based on events participated in.
- ii. It was agreed that a credit structure would be put in place for 2021 for those competitors who qualify and choose to redeem the credit from 2020 licensing fees
- iii. Approx \$10,000.00 worth of credits will be available for 2021 increasing projected deficit for 2021
- iv. CARS BOD is looking at ways to reduce expenses for 2021
- v. Bulletin to be issued

b. CRC

- i. With the final cancellation of RMR the championship will not be awarded for 2020 as there were not enough events run.
- ii. The 2021 calendar was discussed and a draft schedule has been approved
- iii. Bulletin to be released

c. Insurance:

i. Martin, John, and Warren are working on an RFP to send out for quotes prior to the end of the year which will include a request for the potential of 10M liability coverage for consideration, as some events have been asked for increased coverage form their respective municipalities.

d. FIA ASN:

- i. CARS continues to work with GDS
- ii. GDS is making headway with establishing a budget, bylaws, insurance package, and is working closely with ACCUS to navigate international licensing.
- iii. CARS hopes to see an affiliation proposal soon.

e. ADMIN:

- i. Some changes proposed around licensing definitions.
- ii. The BOD indicated that the regional director needs to be involved in licensing decision with the NSM especially when the competitor is looking for an exemption.
- iii. ADMIN rules committee continues to work on licensing discussion related to co-driver vs driver issued licenses.

iv. Rally car licensing and Insurance: BOD agreed that more competitor education is required in order for the programs in AB and BC to be more subscribed from competitors, this may insure the continuation of the govt programs.

- **a.** Virtual events Next one planned for Nov 21 talk of a 2021 series Louis to talk to competitors to gauge interest
- b. ORRC Still Northern Lights left in the season. 2020 ORRC season will be a total of 5 events but only 4 events will count towards the championship. Competitors will have the opportunity to improve their points at Northern Lights by dropping their worst event, or completing their 4th event of the season. Louis will touch base with 2021 ORRC organizers to make sure they are on track to host the events. First event of the season would be MLRC's Polar Bear Rally Ross believes that Bruce L is still hoping to run the event. It's easier to be covid compliant with a navigational event than a performance rally event.

7. Performance Rally Report - Alan -

- a. Performance Rally:
 - i. 2021 Rallye Perce Neige Cancelled
 - **ii. 2021 LHFR** up in the air but hoping to be run around the usual date looking at making a few changes to comply with local route requests.

 - a. MCO tire request for RallyX MCO would like to allow rallyX vehicles to use DOT approved studs in competition. There are no rules to say they can't be used. Advice from discussion was to be mindful of damage they could do to the course, and fairness to competitors perhaps a separate class for these vehicles? MCO would like to try it out to see if it will bring in more competitors, especially those from Quebec as the facility is very close to the provincial border. Events will be held at Capital City Speedway.

13. Club News -

- a. Kitchener-Waterloo Rally Club (KWRC) (per Martin Loveridge)
 - i. RallyX: After having to postpone our October RallyCross weekend as the track had been sold the week before we've finally come to an agreement with the new owners to run rallycrosses at Humberstone again. The permissions came too late to run our Nov. 21/22 postponed event but we have plans for January 24/25 and February 20/21 2021.
 - ii. Virtual Navigational Rally: Doug Green is releasing another virtual navigational rally on Nov. 21. "A Christmas Rally" A trip through the countryside at Christmas while meeting some interesting people along the way. It will be similar to some of the other virtual rallies we have had. Instructions are more or less regular rally type instructions, and you plot the route on Google Maps and work out the ETs. The "route card" will be a set of Google Forms, and you will receive "sticker" information (including GPS coordinates) after you enter info for each Checkpoint. The scoresheet will be available at all times so you see your, and other competitors, progress.
