- 6. Navigational Rally Report Louis
  - a. **Event**s: Blossom has run since the last meeting. The event went well with the usually number of entries. Next event is Discover Ontario on June 25<sup>th</sup> then there will be a lull during the summer until the events return in the Fall
  - **b.** Class & scoring Further Discussion to be had on rule updates (see notes below regarding rules from last meeting)
    - Appendix B Time Allowances Louis proposed a rule change to eliminate the wording "challenging winter conditions". It was discussed at the previous meeting & others feel that this should stay in the ruleset. Louis wanted to revisit it & feels that the wording needs to change. Not necessarily to remove it but adjust it to be more appropriately worded eg. Adverse Driving Conditions or something that describes sudden winter weather changes.

Louis will put together a proposal for the wording change and bring it back to the next RSO meeting for discussion/approval.

 Navigation Rally Rules – Louis has some changes that he'd like to be discussed – mainly around wording and the reference to the 'rallySport Ontario Technical coordinator".

After discussion it was agreed by the board that the reference to the 'rallysport Ontario Technical coordinator" can be removed from the rule set. Louis will make these adjustments and we will make sure the rule set is updated.
