- 4. CARS update Warren From July 26th meeting
 - a. **CRC** Very well prepared and run Rallye BDC, with many initiatives employed to engage the community and fans. Some learning discussed to pass onto other events through organizer group. Some discussion was had as to the extent CARS should make some of the best practices part of the championship. Subaru Trophy delivery date TBD
 - b. **Portneuf report:** Great support from the community. Recognised they NEED to have RS in the course cars. R5 car won outright, in homologated trim.
 - c. **Subaru update**: Signed contract for 6 + BDC event working with Subaru to refine the deliverables for the sponsorship for 22.
 - d. **Marketing**: Working with Formula to direct their efforts for 22 and social for 23.
 - e. **Admin Rules:** Minor updates to some of the administrative rules relating to RS to better embed this process within the rule set.
 - f. **Technical rules:** Classic rally championship class in the works, small group assigned to this project Graham, Martin and Warren.

5. Old Business -

- a. Navigational Rule changes
 - i. Time Allowance Section Wording of "challenging winter driving conditions" Louis requested that the wording "Challenging winter driving conditions" be removed from the rules and the word 'unexpected' also removed from later on in the sentence Board approved
 - ii. RSO Technical coordinator mention of this role has also been removed from the Navigational rally rules as the role is not used currently. Board approved the changes. Anything that would go through the 'RSO technical coordinator' goes through the event organizer &/or Navigational VP.
 - iii. Updates to Rules document Louis to update Navigational Rally Rules revision to wording regarding driving conditions & will post on RSO website

6. Navigational Rally Report – Louis

a. Discover Ontario (ORRC) June 25 – wasn't well attended. Only 2 expert teams and 2 novice teams. Even still ran but it was disappointing that there weren't more entries. It's usually a well-attended event – some regulars were missing due to other commitments.

7. Performance Rally Report – Brandon –

- a. **Performance Rally: Black Bear Rally** on Aug 6 went well. 8/10 finishers. Lots of positive comments from the competitors. A couple of codrivers were sick from the heat but it was managed very well. Some minor issues at tech but things were resolved. Lots of new volunteers that Ross paired with more experienced people and it worked out well.
- b. **RallySprint** Struggling to find organizers for the events. KWRC RallySprint may have to be cancelled for 2022.
- c. **RallyCross** Still great grassroots entry level. PMSC & KWRC getting decent numbers, but MLRC is struggling a little to find the same level of entry.
- d. **Prize Fund** Prizes were well received at Black Bear & Brandon is currently finalizing fund eligibility for the competitors in the OPRC results tables.

- 9. Scrutineer's report Chris Krepski Had a couple of very keen helpers at BBR. Some minor fixes. Roderick Jones' car was the only car to logbook recently. There were 2 more coming down the pipes but Chris hasn't heard from them recently.
- 10. Equipment Managers report Ross Wood Getting low on yellow caution tape. CARS \$30/roll. Princess Auto on sale \$10/roll. Ross to order some from each location and the CARS tape will be used in official areas/spectator areas and the cheaper tape will be used in the woods to block of trails etc.

Certification on the trailer will be done before Tall Pines.

Rallye Defi will not be using RSO Timing equipment. (will have whistles/wristwatch as back-up for RallySafe)

- d. Ottawa Sports Car Club (OSCC) (per Mike Koch) No Report
- Peterborough Motor Sports Club (PMSC) (Per Louis Cabardos) Autocross – July 17 event had 17 competitors but the most recent event was cancelled. Final event scheduled for Sept 4 RallyCross – June 25 (30 competitors), July 16 (26 competitors), Last weekend (24 competitors). Next event set for Sept 17 with MLRC event the following day. Some competitors are camping on location & doing the 'double header'.
