# 4. CARS Regional Rally Director report - Warren

Combined from April 3 and May 11 CRS BOD meetings

- a. Budget: Reported that licence sales uptick in the first portion of the year partly due to the permanent numbering process.
- b. CRC: Both Western events RMR and PFR have taken place and BDC docs well in hand with new roads proposed for the route.
- c. New positions: Executive Director role candidate in hand. NSM and Safety Delegate remain unfilled.
- d. Sponsorship: Pirelli sponsorship proposal work continues
- e. Technical rep: Boost monitoring took place with the use of developed units expecting reports back from RMR and PFR.
- f. ARC: Updates to the rule book updating process have been established are in place
- g. Championship Scoring not a lot of feedback yet, still in discussion no update.
