4. CARS Regional Rally Director report - David C.

- a. CARS AGM was held earlier this month.
 - i. Elections:
 - 1. Bill Westhead was elected as CARS President
 - 2. CARS Technical Director: Matt Pullen
 - 3. CARS Organizer Rep: Nicki Lachapelle
 - 4. RRD for Ontario: David Cotie
 - ii. A couple of motions were passed
 - 1. For CARS to look at how to involve members in the election of the CARS President rather than it just being decided upon by the BOD
 - 2. For the CARS meeting minutes to be readily available in a timely manner so that Clubs & members are more aware of what is going on.
- b. BOD & extended Board (RRDs) had one on one meetings with the new CARS president to address current issues/questions. David brought up discussions regarding the format of the CRC and safety certification in Ontario. RSO are trying to work on this but it would be good to have CARS backing RSO up as well

5. Old Business

- a. Rally car licencing in Ontario David M David was able to talk with the Transportation Minister and he has referred it to the appropriate person to look into it further. on-going.
- b. Regional Technical Delegate Warren ML believes we should look for someone to fill the role of Event Scrutineer as well as Regional Technical Delegate. Warren is willing to help out for now and assist with training someone in that role
- **c. RSO Bylaws** -RS & ML to go over the Bylaws for further issues, but the current version with the 2023 AGM discussed adjustments can be posted to the RSO website.
- d. **RRD**. David Cotie was acclaimed at the CARS AGM
- e. RSO AGM March 15/25.

6. Navigational Rally Report - Louis

- a. First event of the year Snowy Safari on Feb 15th. Start location has been secured and the rest of the organization is well on its way to being completed.
- b. 2024 ORRC awards were handed out at the KWRC banquet, that went well.

7. Performance Rally Report - Brandon

- a. **Performance**: First OPRC event of the season is Rallye Perce Neige Maniwaki on Feb 1st. So far, only a couple of ON teams are entered. 5 events on the calendar for 2025, with event #2 being KWRC's performance event Rally of the Voyageurs on the Fire Access (Quarry Rd) at Catchacoma on April 5th.
- **b. Rallysprint:** MLRC has 2 on the calendar The Club has secured some cash sponsorship for these events. No further update at this time
- c. RallyCross: There was a prelim meeting between MCO & PMSC to run a double header weekend at Free Flow this season. BP is positive we can run a similar championship series in 2025 that we did in 2024. MLRC is in talks with a possible RX venue in 2026

11. Growth Initiatives -

- a. OPRC Sponsorship & Video production proposal (Bruce Leonard) Novus Auto Group would again like to provide sponsorship for the 2025 season but in a different manner than previous seasons. There will be no prize fund for 2025, but will more than likely involve video creation. Still in discussion but there have been several ideas floated around (interviews with teams/event organizers regarding event preparation etc). Matt will be talking to his media team and videographers to see what the proposed budget can get him. More updates to follow. It was suggested that a group be formed (3 folks from the rally side & 3 from Novus) to discuss the organization of it all, once Matt has confirmation from his marketing team.
- Possible additional sponsorship opportunities Ross has a contact that may be willing to put some money towards advertising and growing the sport. RW & ML to discuss offline.

12. New Business -

- OPRC car classes for 2025 specifically 2WD production (Martin) This needs more indepth offline discussion before delving into it at an RSO meeting - Martin to head this discussion.
- b. 2025 RSO Budget The 2024 and 2025 budget was discussed, and it was decided that the RSO fees/levies for 2025 will remain the same as 2024. The 2025 Sponsorship will not feature in the RSO budget as RSO will not be handling the money it will more than likely be in the form of video production rather than a monetary amount that can be included in the budget. It was noted that it is unclear as to whether St Lac will affiliate for 2025.
